### **The Lodge at Longleat**

#### Access

The Lodge at Longleat is located approximately 250yds from the Bath Arms at Longleat. The lodge originally formed part of the main gates to Longleat House. The lodge directly overlooks the house, park and lakes.

There is a parking area immediately before the lodge on the right hand side next to the geese and chicken pen! Access to the lodge is from inside the arch. Please be extremely careful when entering and exiting the building. Some vehicles do not obey the speed restrictions.

There is a security barrier between the hotel and the lodge which is opened at 7am and closed in the evenings at 6.30pm. Access to and exit from the lodge outside of these hours is available using a key held at The Bath Arms.

If you wish, you can drive your car at night from the lodge towards the hotel and park on the side of the drive without causing obstruction to the barrier. The hotel is 10 yards from this point.

If you plan to arrive after the security barrier has been closed, having collected the keys, you will have to drive back round to the main entrance to Longleat and drive to the lodge via these gates. We will give you a map.

#### In Emergency

There is no telephone at the lodge, so please bring a mobile telephone. There is reception at the lodge for most mobile service providers.

#### Facilities

The lodge has a master bedroom and a bunk bedroom. There is a sitting area with floor cushions at the top of the building with full audio visual equipment and

sky channels. On the ground floor there is a kitchen/dining room, bathroom and loo.

The fridge may be stocked with breakfast items for your arrival should you wish. Please feel free to bring your own food, alternatively, We'd love to have you eating at the hotel as well.

#### Night time lighting and torches

There is an external light above the back door. However should you wish to walk up to the hotel for dinner during your stay and your navigation by starlight is a bit rusty please bring a torch.
